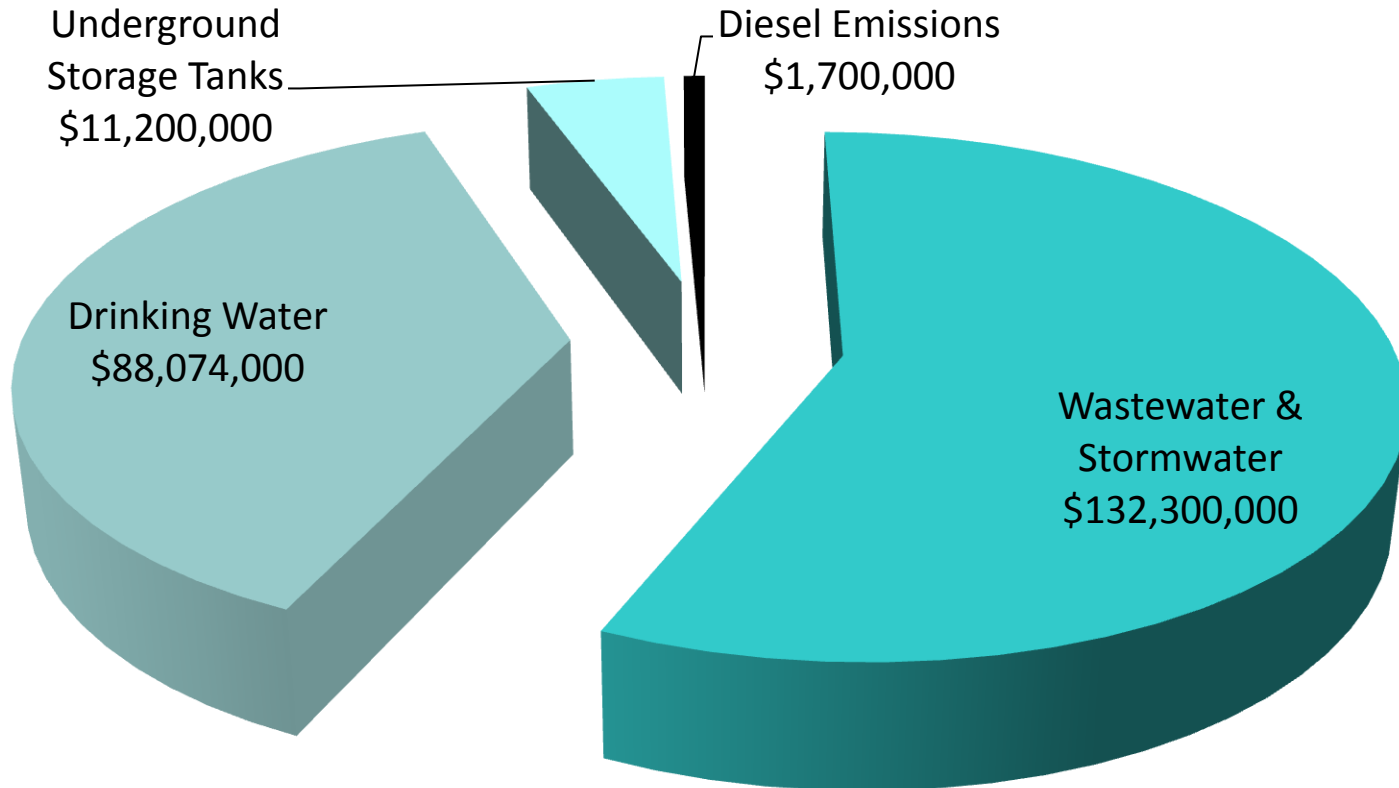
ARRA Funding through DEP

- Existing programs
- Additional federal requirements
- Tight deadlines
- Extensive reporting





ARRA Funding Allocated to DEP





Diesel Emissions Reduction

- \$1.7 million
- School bus retrofits
- Truck stop electrification
- Trucker rebates for anti-idling



Leaking Underground Storage Tanks

- \$11.2 million
- “Orphan” sites
 - No viable responsible party
- 37 current candidates under review
- Funding to pre-approved contractors



Other Funding

- Direct EPA funding
 - Superfund
 - \$25 million - 3 contaminated sites
 - Brownfields
 - \$2.2 million total - 4 local governments
- Direct Army Corps of Engineers funding - \$222.4 million
 - 80 projects, including **~\$100 million for Everglades**
- *Competitive Grants for which DEP is applying*
 - *Greenways & Trails - 4 projects funded through DOT*
 - *State Parks - pending*
 - *Coastal & Aquatic Managed Areas - pending*





Clean Water State Revolving Fund

- \$132.3 million
- Wastewater & stormwater construction
- Low-interest loans
 - 50% to disadvantaged
 - 20% “green”
- Construction by February 2010



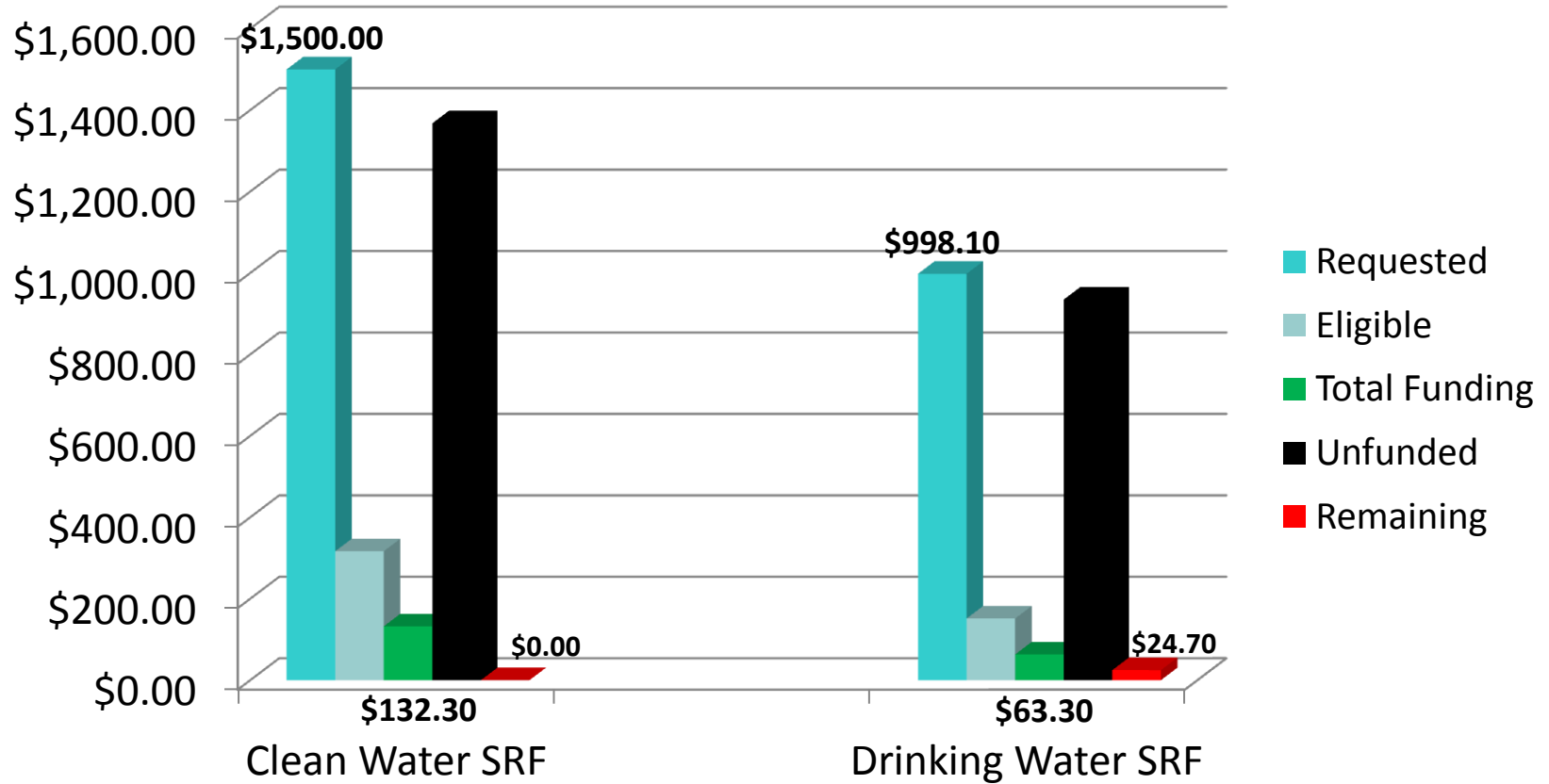
Drinking Water State Revolving Fund

- \$88.1 million
- Drinking water construction
- Low-interest loans
 - 50% to disadvantaged
 - 20% “green”
- Construction by February 2010
