

The BRH86M serves nearly 25,000 visitors per year, with over 40% of them coming from outside Paim Beach County, making it an ideal location to educate these consumers on the wonderful attractions the area has to offer. 





The goal for the Pedestrian Promenade and Sanborn Square Arches public space project was to create a comfortable and visually engaging pedestrian scale environment connecting all of the parts of Downtown Boca, while providing appropriate accommodation of vehicular movement.









Elements of the improvements included a curbless street and flexible spaces with open, walkable public areas, pedestrian crossings and a pair of arches that serve as landmark guideposts.











