- Proposed Committee Bill <u>WMC 1</u> (Ways & Means Committee Bill) Increased Homestead
 Property Tax Exemption Oppose WMC 1 passed the House Ways & Means Committee (16-8) today, January 8. This proposed committee bill will now be assigned a House bill number, bill sponsor, and committee assignments.
- Proposed Committee Bill <u>WMC 2</u> (Ways & Means Committee Bill) Annual Inflation Adjustment to Homestead Exemption Oppose WMC 2 passed the House Ways & Means Committee (16-8) today, January 8. This proposed committee bill will now be assigned a House bill number, bill sponsor, and committee assignments.

- SB 688 (Martin) and HB 479 (W. Robinson) Alternative Mobility Funding Systems Support –
 SB 688 will be heard on Tuesday, January 9, in the Senate Community Affairs Committee at 4:30
 p.m. This is the first of three committee stops in the Senate. HB 479 has three committee
 references and has not yet been heard in a committee.
- <u>SB 1184</u> (Ingoglia) and <u>HB 1221</u> (McClain) Land Use and Development Regulations Oppose Both bills were filed last week and have not yet received committee references. Share this legislation with your land use professionals and provide feedback to David on how this bill would impact your city.

Jeff Branch Update:

 SB 328 (Calatayud) and HB 1239 (V. Lopez) Development/Live Local Act – Support – SB 328 will be heard on Tuesday, January 9, in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of two committee stops in the Senate. HB 1239 was filed last week and has not yet received committee assignments.

Rebecca O'Hara Update:

- HB 777 (Brackett) and SB 1088 (Martin) Municipal Water or Sewer Utility Rates, Fees and Charges – Oppose – Both bills have three committee references and have not yet been scheduled for a committee hearing.
- <u>HB 1277</u> (Busatta Cabrera) and <u>SB 1510</u> (Brodeur) **Municipal Utilities** Oppose Both bills were filed last week and have not yet received committee references.

Sam Wagoner Update:

- <u>SB 280</u> (DiCeglie) Vacation Rentals Oppose SB 280 passed out of its first committee of reference, the Regulated Industries Committee, on December 13. It has one more committee stop in the Senate, the Fiscal Policy Committee. The Fiscal Policy Committee meets this Thursday, January 11 at 10:00 a.m. We will find out today at 2:30 p.m. if SB 280 will be on this week's committee agenda. At this time, there is no House companion bill.
- <u>SB 1322</u> (Ingoglia) and <u>HB 1195</u> (Garrison) **Millage Rate Increase Monitor** Both bills were filed last week and have not yet received committee references.
- <u>SB 972</u> (Gruters) and <u>HB 1459</u> (McFarland) **Artificial Intelligence** Monitor SB 972 has three Senate committee references and has not yet had a committee hearing. HB 1459 was filed last week and has not yet received committee references.
