

Summary of February 12, 2024, FLC Morning Call-In

Rebecca O'Hara Update:

- [SB 7040](#) (Environment and Natural Resources) and [HB 7053](#) (Water Quality, Supply & Treatment) **Ratification of the Department of Environmental Protection's Relating to Stormwater** – **Support** – SB 7040 will be heard in the Senate Rules Committee on February 14 at 9:00 a.m. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. The next committee stop for HB 7053 is the House Infrastructure Strategies Committee. We will know by 4:30 p.m. on February 13 if HB 7053 is on the committee's agenda.
- [SB 1628](#) (Collins) and [HB 1547](#) (McClure) **Local Government Actions** – **Oppose** – Both bills may be heard in a committee this week. The next committee stop for SB 1628 is the Senate Fiscal Policy Committee. We will know by 2:30 p.m. today if SB 1628 is on the committee's agenda for their February 15 meeting. The next stop for HB 1547 is the House State Affairs Committee. Their next meeting is on February 14, and we will know by 4:30 p.m. today if HB 1547 will be on the committee's agenda.

- [SB 812](#) (Ingoglia) and [HB 665](#) (McClain) **Expedited Approval of Residential Building Permits** – **Oppose** – SB 812 will be heard in the Senate Rules Committee on February 14 at 9:00 a.m. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. HB 665 passed all its committees and is now eligible to be considered by the full House.
- [HB 609](#) (Botana) and [SB 1144](#) (DiCeglie) **Local Business Taxes** – **Oppose** – HB 609 has one more committee stop in the House, the House State Affairs Committee. We will know by 4:30 p.m. today if HB 609 is on the committee's February 14 agenda. SB 1144 has not been heard in any committee.

- [SB 1526](#) (Avila) and [HB 1647](#) (Roach) **Local Regulation of Nonconforming and Unsafe Structures** – **Oppose** – SB 1526 will be heard in the Senate Rules Committee on February 14 at 9:00 a.m. This is the final committee stop for SB 1526. The next committee stop for HB 1647 is the House State Affairs Committee. We will know by 4:30 p.m. today if HB 1647 will be on the committee's February 14 meeting agenda.
- [SB 808](#) (DiCeglie) and [HB 637](#) (Yeager) **Treatment by a Medical Specialist** – **Monitor** – SB 808 will be heard in the Senate Appropriations Committee on Agriculture, Environment, and General Government on February 13 at 8:30 a.m. This is the second of three committee stops in the Senate. HB 637 has one more committee stop, the House Commerce Committee. We will know by 4:30 p.m. on February 13 if HB 637 is on the committee's February 15 meeting agenda.
- [HB 479](#) (W. Robinson) and [SB 688](#) (Martin) **Alternative Mobility Funding Systems** – **Support** – HB 479 has passed all of its committees of reference and now heads to the House floor for consideration. The next and final committee stop for SB 688 is the Senate Rules Committee. SB 688 is not on this week's Senate Rules Committee agenda.

- [SB 472](#) (Brodeur) and [HB 569](#) (McFarland) **Suits Against the Government/Sovereign Immunity – Oppose** – The next committee stop for SB 472 is the Senate Appropriations Committee. We will know by 2:30 p.m. today if SB 472 is on the committee’s February 15 agenda. The next and final committee stop for HB 569 is the House Judiciary Committee. We will know by 4:30 p.m. today if HB 569 is on the committee’s February 14 agenda.

- [SB 684](#) (DiCeglie) and [HB 267](#) (Esposito) **Residential Building Permits – Oppose** – The next committee stop for SB 684 is the Senate Fiscal Policy Committee. We will know by 2:30 p.m. today if SB 684 is on the committee’s February 15 meeting agenda. The next and final committee stop for HB 267 is the House Commerce Committee. We will know by 4:30 p.m. on February 13 if HB 267 is on the committee’s February 15 meeting agenda. The next and final committee stop for HB 1537 is the Commerce Committee. We will know by 4:30 p.m. on February 13 if HB 1537 is on the committee’s February 15 meeting agenda.
